Steve Godfrey grew up in the town of East Longmeadow, Massachusetts. He received his Bachelors of Fine Arts Degree from the Hartford Art School in 1993. He went on to spend a year studying at the Kansas City Art Institute. He received his Masters of Fine Arts Degree from New York State College of Ceramics at Alfred University in 1996. In 1998, Steve spent the year as a resident artist at The Archie Bray Foundation for Ceramic Arts. In 1999, Steve accepted the position of term instructor and ceramics area technician at the University of Alaska Anchorage. In 2004, Steve was hired as the area head of the ceramics at UAA. Presently, Steve is finishing up a sabbatical from teaching during which he was a short term artist in residence at the Archie Bray Foundation for Ceramic Arts in Helena, MT.

Aside from teaching, Steve has been consistently making and showing his work. He has participated in numerous exhibitions and sales throughout Alaska and the lower forty-eight. Recently, he was invited to be a featured artist at the Clay Studio in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and also participate in the Northern Clay Center American Pottery Festival in Minneapolis Minnesota.
